The Do-Dah Parade

June 7, 2025 Step-off at 11 a.m. Gates open at 9 a.m.



Overview:

The "Do-Dah Parade" is Saturday, June 7, 2025 at 11 am. The parade is 41 years old and has been a tradition of laughter and a bit of "silliness" as companies and organizations take to the street to make a satire parade, something people can laugh about and remember. It is about community and bringing people together to celebrate where they work, their businesses and to share that with the community through laughter!

Do-Dah started in 1984, when WKMI organizers designed the parade as a way for companies and organizations to provide unique entertainment through a satire and host a parade that wasn't "stuffy." The purpose remains the same – create the un-structured, spontaneous, and totally hilarious parade. Each year, participants are challenged to reinvigorate the meaning of "Do-Dah" (a satire based on irony and/or an iconic use of a person, place, event or thing).

This is the application for the parade. You can either use this paper application or you can sign up online (preferred) at https://www.surveymonkey.com/r/DoDahParade. Please complete the application and send back by May 16. Applications will be accepted after this date, but placement will be at the end of the parade (with Santa).

Here are the parade highlights:

- 1. Units must be themed either through a stated satire or the yearly theme. This year's theme is "Once Upon Time."
- 2. Do-Dah Parade depends on the parade units being entertaining. That means that everyone needs to wear costumes that either follow the theme, have a satire, or decorated to create a visual appeal on the streets.
- 3. The parade application fee is \$70 for nonprofits and community groups; and \$85 for for-profits. There are affordable sponsorship opportunities available to provide great exposure for your company including free entries. The entry fee for the parade pays for less than 10% of the cost to host this event. Sponsors help the event be more sustainable. - 4. Please make sure to complete **all** portions of the application including the waiver statement. Remember, you can conveniently submit this application online (preferred). Confirmations will be sent via email. <u>If you do not receive email confirmation within a week of sending in your application</u>, please call us (269-388-2830). The final line-up information will also be posted about two weeks prior to the event at <u>www.dodahkzoo.com</u>.

There are two ways to participate in Do-Dah: a) unit based on a spoof or a satire of a person, place, event or thing; or b) have your unit fit the theme of "Once Upon a Time". In the application, you will provide a description which will be used to promote your participation prior to the parade and create human interest stories. Remember, businesses that connect the theme to the costumes make more impactful "WOW" experiences.

- Entries are arranged in the parade based on their entertainment value. Your entry placement will be determined based on how you theme your unit, how you describe it. The more decorated and themed your unit is, the better the return rate. Parade vehicles MUST be decorated as part of the theme.
- ❖ ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE IN COSTUME! This means general street clothes do not qualify as a costume.
- Each unit needs a parade banner or sign promoting the organization or group to help people to vote.
- Vehicles and floats must be of good working order and state licensed-approved.
- Semi-trucks will be placed at the end of the parade lineup.
- We reserve the right to not accept or remove a unit if it is offensive, inappropriate, unsafe, or poorly reflects the integrity of the parade.
- Due to the nature of the event and the cost for city services, entry fees cannot be refunded.
- Entry fees must be paid a week prior to the event.

Upon receipt of the application, a confirmation with an invoice for payment will be sent via email.

Payments must be completed prior to the event.

"Once Upon a Time" Theme: If embracing a satire feels a tad daunting, consider following the 2025 theme through creative planning. The theme for this year is "Once Upon a Time," and you can take it from the perspective of a storybook, a historical look back at your company, or a look back at a "time when...."

This open-ended theme allows for creativity and even an opportunity to really promote your business. We believe that Do-Dah provides an opportunity to be creative about your promotion of your business and what you do to make our community amazing. Businesses are encouraged to make signage, carry a banner, and promote who they are and what they love to do. The Once upon a Time theme also allows the creativity to think back to when you started your business and the vision you had for your product. Have fun with this theme.

Satire: an attempt or imitation that is so poor that it seems ridiculous – but in good taste. Amusing - Imitation - a piece of writing or music that deliberately copies another work in a comical or satirical way. Think "Saturday Night Live" as an example of satire. Just watch an episode of Saturday Night Life to get ideas. Seriously!

Let's Stimulate Creativity

Thanks to the support of the Irving S. Gilmore Foundation and their challenge for creativity and artistic expression for the Do-Dah Parade, a series of Ideation Initiatives will be conducted to coach entry units on creativity, satire development, and the simple tricks of decorating.

Watch the Facebook posts, Instagram ideas, and videos on how to make a parade unit engaging. These posts are quick, easy DIY projects that participants can easily imitate and use in their unit. The spirit of Do-Dah is fun and unique. If you are using the satire theme, it's all about making good, light-hearted fun of ourselves.

Word of Advice: Call us, we love to brainstorm on themes, decorating, and even event day preparation. We will work to make it easier on you. With the theme being "Once Upon a Time", the options are endless. Bottom line: have fun with it!

Do-Dah Parade

General Parade Information and Guidelines

The Purpose: The Do-Dah Parade has been in existence for 41 years, since 1984, and was designed to create a

laughable parade that provides entertainment through a satire, spoof, or a theme while

promoting local businesses.

Parade Date: Saturday, June 7, 2025

Check-in: The parade begins downtown at the Bronson Healthcare Group Parking Lot on Lovell Street and

ends in the same location. Parade units are assigned a specific parade staging location. A representative from the parade unit must check-in with the official by the time stated in the

final information packet. The lot opens at 9 a.m. for check-in.

Parade Time: Parade steps off at 11 a.m.

Parade Route: The route starts at Lovell Street and Jasper, then travels on Lovell to Rose Street, Rose Street to

Michigan Avenue, Michigan Avenue to Portage Street, and Portage Street back to Lovell Street. Cars cannot park along the parade staging areas and streets. And there is no parking or viewing

on Bronson Park side of Rose St. from Academy St. to South St.

Viewing Stand: You are performing the entire time you are on the street – this is why you are in costume. Units

may not stop to perform; performances must have "momentum."

Noise Restrictions: Please do not use horns or sirens unless an emergency exists. Sound amplifier range must be

limited to your entry.

Animal Units: You are required to have someone cleaning up behind your animal (especially horses) at all

times. A fine will be assessed for clean-up expenses. The parking lot can be hot, please make

sure that your animals are cared for with water and safety from the hot pavement.

Signage: Signage must be appropriate and complement the satire theme. Vehicles must be decorated to

match the theme.

Parade Vehicles: Only vehicles designated on your application will be allowed in the staging area. Band

equipment vehicles will be allowed in the staging area, but not on the parade route. **ALL UNITS**

MUST BE DECORATED COMPLETELY and follow the theme/satire.

Floats: Trailers are not allowed in the Bronson Healthcare Parking Lot area (this is a risk management

directive). If you have a trailer, please check the float box in the application. Trailers must be

state licensed-approved and all safety and precaution measures must be implemented.

Approved railings and seating is required for anyone traveling on the float. Floats cannot exceed

12 feet high from the ground.

Distribution: For the safety of others, <u>no items may be thrown</u> from your parade unit, including candy,

souvenirs, and balloons. Items for distribution must be approved. Designated walkers should be

used to hand the items to the spectators.

Disclaimer: The Do-Dah Parade Committee reserves the right to remove any entry from the parade before

and during the parade if the entry is not as stated in the parade application, or is otherwise

deemed unsuitable.

Final Note: We all want every unit to be able to promote who they are and what they do. This is

community. The entries that are themed, costumed, and really funny will up-stage the units that

are not. If you want to be remembered, follow these instructions for a successful entry.
